

## **Talking Points from KMHC Board Meeting 3/23/21**

- Board Bylaws Committee performing final review of updated KMHC bylaws. Full set of bylaws will be shared with all townships and village. Bylaws will be presented at April Board meeting with approval requested at May meeting.
- COVID-19 Update:
  - KMHC continues to hold vaccine clinics; now scheduling for ages 16 and older. If interested, please email [KMHC-CovidVaccine@mhc.net](mailto:KMHC-CovidVaccine@mhc.net). You will then receive a form you must complete which will go to the vaccine scheduling team.
  - Please check KMHC's Facebook page for up to date information on vaccine status.
  - Positivity rates continue to increase in Kalkaska as well as region.
  - Munson Healthcare seeing significant increase of COVID positive patients requiring hospitalization.
  - KMHC is going to be the first site in Munson Healthcare to pilot providing monoclonal antibody (mAB) infusions. This treatment is for those that have a positive COVID-19 test, and had symptoms for 10 days or less, and are at high risk of getting more serious symptoms.
- KMHC Senior Leadership presented the draft KMHC Strategic Plan and will ask for approval at the April meeting. The Strategic Plan includes 10 areas of focus and corresponding action plans:
  - Awareness, Communication and Marketing/Stewardship of Community Resources
  - Increase KMHC's Capability to Care for a Higher Level of Acuity Patient
  - Enhance Physician Recruitment, Relationships and Expand KMA
  - Board and Community Relationships
  - Wellness and Chronic Disease Management
  - Manage and Adapt to Reimbursement Changes
  - Enhance Staff Engagement and Enhancement of Organizational Clarity
  - Maximize KMHC's Relationship with Munson Healthcare
  - Enhance Senior Services
  - New Service Development
- Construction/Campus Update:
  - Construction has commenced on the Behavioral Health buildout on the second floor of the Medical Pavilion.
- Actions to be taken at April Meeting:
  - KMHC Strategic Plan approval.
